AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. LUGAR

Viz:

1 On page 7, after line 11, add the following:

2 **SEC. 5. REPORT ON COSTS AND IMPACT OF MILITARY OP-**
3 **ERATIONS.**

4 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 15 days after the enact-
5 ment of this joint resolution and every 60 days thereafter,
6 the President shall submit to the President of the Senate
7 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a report
8 containing the following information:

9 (1) The total cost incurred by the United States
10 Government in connection with military operations
11 in Libya since their commencement on March 19,
12 2011.

1 (2) The total cost incurred by the United States
2 Government in connection with military operations
3 in Libya during the preceding 30 days.

4 (3) The sources and amounts of any reimburse-
5 ments the United States has received from other
6 countries for costs it has incurred in connection with
7 military operations in Libya since their commence-
8 ment on March 19, 2011.

9 (4) A list of United States Government direct
10 spending programs whose budgetary resources will
11 be reduced to pay for any unreimbursed costs associ-
12 ated with United States military operations in Libya
13 since their commencement on March 19, 2011, and
14 the amount by which the budgetary resources of
15 each such program shall be reduced.

16 (5) An assessment of the impact of United
17 States military operations in Libya on the capacity
18 and resources of the United States military to carry
19 out effective United States military operations
20 against al Qaeda and the Taliban pursuant to the
21 Authorization for Use of Military Force (Public Law
22 107-40; 50 U.S.C. 1541 note), passed in the after-
23 math of the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks.

24 (6) An assessment of the impact of military op-
25 erations in Libya conducted by NATO member

1 countries on the capacity and resources of NATO
2 member countries to participate effectively in other
3 NATO operations, including in Afghanistan.

4 (b) SUNSET.—The requirement in subsection (a)
5 shall terminate 30 days after the President notifies the
6 President pro tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of
7 the House of Representatives in writing that United
8 States military operations in Libya have ended.
